



Declaration of intention No Gift Policy (No Gift Policy)

The Office of the Basic Education Commission has a policy for the Office of Educational service areas to comply with the Constitution on Prevention and Suppression of Corruption B.E. ๒๐๑๘, section ๑๒๖, paragraph one stipulates that no government official shall receive property or any other benefit which may be calculated in the form of money from any person. Other than assets or reasonable benefit under the law, rules or regulations issued by virtue of the law and except for the receipt of assets or any other benefits in an ethical manner in accordance with the rules and amounts prescribed by the NACC ITA.

In order to prevent corruption and misconduct by government officials All staff and personnel in the school is aware of corruption. It is an important problem that all sectors must work together to eliminate. The operating in accordance with the policy of the Office of the Basic Education Commission and the declaration of good intentions of Ban Kad Wittayakom School. Therefore, there is a policy of not accepting gifts in all festivals (NO GIFT POLICY). "Change gifts to be blessings". This is to avoid actions that may affect discretion or decision-making in the performance of duties, which leads to discrimination or creates a conflict of interest.
